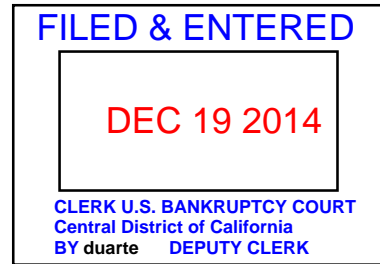

**ORDER AUTHORIZING PRODUCTION
OF DOCUMENTS AND EXAMINATION
OF A-MARK PRECIOUS METALS, INC.
PURSUANT TO FED. R. BANKR. P. 2004**

**[NO HEARING REQUIRED PURSUANT
TO L.B.R. 2004-1(d)]**

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19 Upon consideration of the *Motion for Order Authorizing the Production of Documents and*
20 *Examination of A-Mark Precious Metals, Inc. Pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2004; Memorandum of*
21 *Points and Authorities in Support Thereof; and Supporting Declarations of Nicholas Troszak and*
22 *Linda F. Cantor* (the “Motion”) filed by the Chapter 7 trustee herein (the “Trustee”); and good cause
23 appearing therefore:

24 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

- 25 1. The Motion is granted as follows;
- 26 2. The Trustee shall issue a subpoena to A-Mark Precious Metals, Inc. for production of
- 27 the documents listed on Exhibit “A”, attached to the Motion, provided however that to the extent the
- 28 Trustee, after review of those documents produced as set forth in Paragraph 3 below (“Initial

1 Production”), seeks the production of documents set forth on the Subpoena other than the Initial
2 Production, the Trustee shall so notify A-Mark whose right to object to the production of such
3 further documents shall be reserved;

4 3. **As to paragraph 2 above, A-Mark Precious Metals, Inc. shall be served in the**
5 **manner set forth in Fed.R.Bankr.P. 7004(b)(3) – service to its attorney only shall not be**
6 **sufficient unless such attorney is specifically authorized by A-Mark Precious Metals, Inc. to**
7 **accept service of process on its behalf;**

8 4. For its initial response to the subpoena, A-Mark will provide the Trustee the
9 following documents **on no less than 14 days’ notice:**


- 10 a. monthly account statements which set forth all transactions between the Tulving
11 Company and A-Mark for the time period requested in the Motion;
12 b. spreadsheets and account ledgers which set forth the details behind the
13 transactions foregoing in MS Excel format; and
14 c. copies of all underlying contract documents between Tulving Company and A-
15 Mark;

16 5. A-Mark will provide assistance to the Trustee in reviewing the foregoing documents
17 and A-Mark will produce additional documents and information if subsequently requested by the
18 Trustee;

19 6. A-Mark shall submit to examination under oath by the Trustee upon twenty-one (21)
20 days written notice; and

21 7. The Court shall maintain jurisdiction of this matter.
