(the "Claimant") having informally responded to the Motion (the "Response") accepting the
reduced amount of its claim but requesting that the record be corrected to reflect that its claim is
based on the <u>sale</u> of coins to Tulving rather than the purchase of coins from Tulving, the Court finds
that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § § 157 and 1334, (b) this is
a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b), (c) notice of the Motion was sufficient and proper,
(d) there was no opposition by the Claimant to the reduction of its claim, and (e) the legal and factual
bases set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The Motion is GRANTED.
- Claim 214-1 is hereby is hereby reduced and allowed in the reduced amount of 2. \$73,232.50.
- 3. Claim 214-1 is based upon Claimant's sale of coins to Tulving for \$73,232.50, which amount was not paid by Tulving.
- 4. The Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to any matters, rights or disputes arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
