- (ii) dispose of all other books, records and files of the Debtor that are or become unnecessary to the administration of the Debtor's case (the "<u>Unnecessary Documents</u>"), and
- (iii) pay for the cost to dispose of the Unnecessary Documents in an amount not to exceed \$600.00.
- 3. This Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation or interpretation of this Order.
