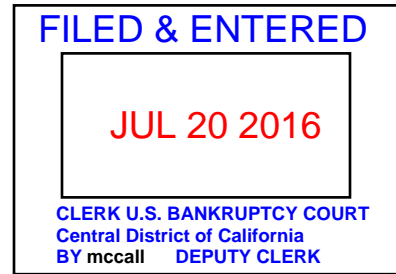

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26 A hearing was held at the above-referenced time and place before the Honorable Erithe
27 Smith, United States Bankruptcy Judge, to consider the *Trustee’s Motion for an Order (i)*
28 *Authorizing the Turnover of Certain Books, Records and Files of the Debtor to*

1 *Greatcollections.Com d/b/a Great Collections, (ii) Authorizing the Disposal of Certain Other Books,*
2 *Records and Files of the Debtor, as they Become Unnecessary, (iii) Authorizing Payment of*
3 *Disposal Costs When Incurred, and (iv) Granting Related Relief (the “Motion”) [Docket No. 576]*
4 *filed by Weneta M.A. Kosmala, the duly appointed chapter 7 trustee (“Trustee”) for the estate of The*
5 *Tulving Company, Inc. (“Debtor”).*¹ Appearances were as noted on the record of the hearing.


6 The Court, having considered the Motion and the declarations in support thereof, the
7 objection to the Motion filed by Karl Klein on behalf of certain customers of the Debtor [Docket No.
8 582] (the “Objection”), and the Trustee’s reply to the Objection [Docket No. 596], and the Court
9 having determined that notice of the Motion was sufficient and proper, good cause appearing for the
10 granting of the Motion and based on the reasons set forth by the Court on the record at the hearing;

11 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

- 12 1. The Motion is granted and the Objection is overruled.
- 13 2. The Trustee is authorized to take such actions as are necessary and appropriate to:
- 14 (a) abandon and turn-over the books, records and files of the Debtor listed on Exhibit A to the
15 Motion, to Greatcollections.Com d/b/a Great Collections;
- 16 (ii) dispose of all other books, records and files of the Debtor that are or become unnecessary
17 to the administration of the Debtor’s case (the “Unnecessary Documents”), and
- 18 (iii) pay for the cost to dispose of the Unnecessary Documents in an amount not to exceed
19 \$600.00.
- 20 3. This Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the
21 implementation or interpretation of this Order.
