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Tracy Law Group, PLLC ("TTLG") belonged to Diane Erdmann. The District Court also affirmed the Bankruptcy Court's order authorizing the employment of TTLG as counsel for the Debtor for the period April 1, 2016 through April 15, 2016. The District Court also affirmed the Bankruptcy Court's order awarding TTLG final compensation in the amount of \$35,715.50 and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$2,239.07. The District Court reversed the Bankruptcy Court's order awarding TTLG sanctions in the amount of \$9,149.50.

- 2. On June 7, 2017, the District Court entered its Judgment in a Civil Case setting forth judgment in accordance with its June 1, 2017 order. The deadline to appeal the District Court's Judgment was July 7, 2017. No further appeals were filed by the Chapter 11 Trustee, Erdmann or TTLG.
- 3. The Chapter 11 Trustee is holding the sum of \$125,857.50, plus any accrued interest. The Chapter 11 Trustee should disburse the funds not otherwise allocated per the Orders and Judgment, plus any accrued interest, to Diane Erdmann.
- 4. By way of background, on March 31, 2016, TTLG received an Advanced Fee Deposit in the sum of \$149,460.00 from Diane Erdmann in the form of a \$50,000.00 wire transfer and a cashier's check payable to Erdmann and endorsed to TTLG. These funds were deposited into TTLG's IOLTA Trust Account. *Transcript July 6, 2016 at 349-350, Docket No. 7.*
- 5. Prior to the filing of the Chapter 11 Petition, TTLG drew down \$21,885.50 for prepetition fees incurred that were related to advising the Debtor. *Docket No. 63*. Additionally, the United States Courts debited \$1,717.00 for the Chapter 11 filing fee, via ACH from the funds in the trust account. *Id.* Accordingly, as of the time of filing and continuing forward, the trust account has a balance of \$125,857.50. *Id.*

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6.	In response to TTLG motion to withdraw as attorney, the Chapter 11 Trustee asserted
that the	funds deposited with TTLG were property of the bankruptcy estate of NWTM.
Docket	Nos. 89, 167. Ms. Erdmann responded and argued that she was the owner of the funds
used fo	r the deposit. TTLG took no position on the ownership of the funds, other than to
indicate	e that the funds should be the source of payment of any final fees that ultimately might
be awa	rded to TTLG by the Bankruptcy Court.

- 7. A contested evidentiary hearing was held. On August 4, 2016, the Bankruptcy Court entered its Memorandum Opinion and Further Order on Motion for Authority to Withdraw as Attorney for Debtor ("Memorandum Opinion"). The Bankruptcy Court held that the disputed funds belonged to Erdmann.
- 8. The Chapter 11 Trustee timely appealed that portion of the Memorandum Opinion. (Appeal No. C16-1323RSL). Erdmann timely cross-appealed that portion of the Memorandum Opinion relating to stay violation(s). (Appeal No C16-1392RSL).
- 9. Now, Diane Erdman requests the funds on-hand, plus interest not otherwise allocated be released to her immediately.
