20	I, Mary E. Olsen, declare as follows:
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22	SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF OLSEN IN SUPPORT OF JOINT MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF CLASS SETTLEMENT AND RELATED RELIEF - 1

- 1. I am a member of The Gardner Firm, PC, one of the law firms appointed as Settlement Class Counsel for Brittany Konkel ("Class Claimant") and the individuals on the attached Settlement Schedule ("Settlement Class Members").
- 2. This declaration is submitted in further support of final approval of the Settlement Agreement (Dkt. No. 1847-1 the "Settlement Agreement"), as requested in the Parties' Joint Motion For An Order (1) Granting Class Certification For Purposes Of Settlement Only; (2) Appointing Settlement Class Representative And Settlement Class Counsel; (3) Preliminarily Approving The Settlement Agreement Between Class Claimant, On Her Own Behalf And On Behalf Of The Settlement Class; (4) Approving The Form And Manner Of Notice To Settlement Class; (5) Scheduling A Final Fairness Hearing For The Final Consideration And Approval Of The Settlement; And (6) Finally, Approving The Settlement (Dkt. No. 1847).
- 3. On September 14, 2018, the Court granted preliminary approval of the Joint Motion.
- 4. Settlement Class Counsel prepared the approved Class Notice and personalized Exhibit A to the Class Notice for each Settlement Class Member to reflect their projected allocation of the Settlement Amount, after the deduction of Settlement Class Counsel's Fees, Settlement Class Counsel's Expenses and the Service Payment.
- 5. On September 18, 2018, Settlement Class Counsel mailed the Class Notice, which included the personalized Exhibit A and the opt-out form, to all Settlement Class Members.
- 6. Settlement Class Counsel used a \$6,000 expense total for purposes of calculating the personalized Settlement Class Member allocations used in Exhibit A to the September 18, 2018 Class Notices. Settlement Class Counsel's expenses in this matter actually exceed \$6,000, but the Parties agreed in the Settlement Agreement that reimbursable expenses would be capped at that amount (Settlement Agreement, para. 3). Settlement Class Counsel's expenses related to the

1	mediation alone, totaled more than \$6,000 (i.e., \$4,460 to Schwabe Williamson & Wyatt
2	(mediator's firm), plus expenses of \$1769 related to attendance at the mediation, which total
3	\$6229). In addition to the mediation related expenses, Settlement Class Counsel incurred costs for
4	legal research; copies; postage (relating to noticing) and PACER charges.
5	7. The attached Settlement Schedule reflects the \$6,000 expense deduction and
6	includes the Settlement Class Member allocations which were used in Exhibit A to the
7	personalized Class Notices mailed to Settlement Class Members on September 18, 2018.
8	8. There were no opt-outs or objections to the Settlement.
9	9. The Parties agree that the attached, updated Settlement Schedule, containing the
	Settlement allocation amount reflected in each Settlement Class Member's September 18, 2018
10	Class Notice, shall govern the Trustee's Settlement distributions in this matter.
11	10. In view of the foregoing and the Joint Motion, the Parties ask the Bankruptcy Court
12	to enter an order for the relief requested in the Joint Motion, and to approve all aspects of the
13	Settlement, including the use of the attached Settlement Schedule for purposes of the Trustee's
14	Settlement distribution.
