4 is hereby approved on a final basis, effective as of April 22, 2016.

5 2. Miller Nash Graham & Dunn LLP is appointed to perform all services
6 necessary to effectively represent the Committee in the above-captioned administratively
7 consolidated bankruptcy case, with compensation and reimbursement of expenses subject to
8 Court approval on notice to creditors and a hearing.
