
Good cause appearing therefor, Plaintiff’s ex parte application for leave to conduct early
discovery (Docket Item No. 34) is GRANTED as follows:

1. Plaintiff is authorized to issue and serve one subpoena to California Bank and Trust for the limited purpose of obtaining information sufficient to identify the location of Defendant Hannes Tulving, Jr.
2. Such subpoena may include the “Definitions and Instructions” proposed by Plaintiff in the ex parte application. See Docket Item No. 35, Ex. A. Such subpoena may also command production of the documents described in paragraphs 1, 2, and 3 as proposed by Plaintiff in the “Requests for the Production of Documents” section of the proposed attachment. Id.
3. However, such subpoena shall not command production of the documents described in paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 of the proposed attachment. Id.

1 4. Any disputes with respect to the discovery authorized herein are referred to the
2 assigned magistrate judge.
